



Association of Architecture Schools of Australasia Code of Conduct

All individuals participating in activities related to the day-to-day running of the Association of Architecture Schools of Australasia are subject to the Association's Code of Conduct. The Code of Conduct sets out the standards of professional behaviour expected of its members and other individuals in contact with the Association.

Code of Conduct articles:

1. All members agree to behave in a respectful and professional manner and perform their assigned duties honestly, diligently and fairly.
2. All members agree to base decisions for the organisation on evidence and vote in fair and conscientious way for the benefits and furthering of the Architecture Education in Australasia and not on personally held views, individual benefits or that of the organisation they represent.
3. All members will make reasonable attempts to attend all meetings and work towards agreed commitments.
4. All members will declare any actual or potential conflict of interest, and where a conflict of interest exists, will agree to withdraw from any decision making on that matter.
5. All members agree to only share information with the relevant parties of their respective institutions unless authorised to do so by the Executive team of the Association.
6. All members agree not to speak on behalf of the Association unless authorised by the Executive team of the Association.
7. All members agree to act responsibly and only use Association's funds and resources appropriately and as agreed.
8. All expenditure incurred by the members of the Association will be clearly communicated and transparently documented using relevant accounting systems.

Affiliate Membership

Non-accredited programs will be given an opportunity to request affiliate membership until the time they become fully accredited.

The affiliate membership will incur \$ 2,100 annual fee. Affiliate members will be invited as observers to the Association's AGM, and will have limited rights until they qualify for and achieve full membership status.
